Walking Through the Design Process: From Concept to Finished Pattern with Garment Designer

Have you ever sat down, ready to create a pattern, but you are not sure where to start? This workshop is for you!

The goal of our 2026 workshop is to introduce and guide you through the *Design Process*; *From Concept to Finished Pattern*. Whether you sew or knit, the approach is the same.

Explore thinking creatively and logically as you plan and build a garment pattern. You will be delighted to discover that it is not rocket science. Rather, it is learned series of steps that you can exercise again, and again; getting faster each time you develop a new pattern.

Our workshop will begin with various exercises that will teach you how to look at an inspiration garment, analyze it, and then develop a plan which includes style details and measurements. You will then build the pattern in Garment Designer. The first pattern will be a simple style for a standard size. We will provide the inspiration for this one. After you have completed that, we will then move on to making decisions of how to adapt that pattern for your own personal measurements and you will then alter the first pattern to suit your body. Once you have this under your belt, you will then move on to your own unique project, working from an inspiration image or garment through to a developed pattern.



Optional Boot Camp Day: Body Measurements and Reviewing Garment Designer Basics

Friday, February 6th, 2026 10 a.m. – 3 p.m.

\$75.00 Minimum: 2 persons

On this day we will walk through the taking of body measurements and the process of entering them in the program. Each student will print out their basic sloper to use as reference when planning garments in the future. We will then explore the basics of Garment Designer.

- people who are new to the software
- those wanting a review
- those who want assistance with their Measurements

Note: If you are somewhat comfortable with the software but want the measurement component, Susan will have a pattern project for you to work on when the others learn some of the software basics.
