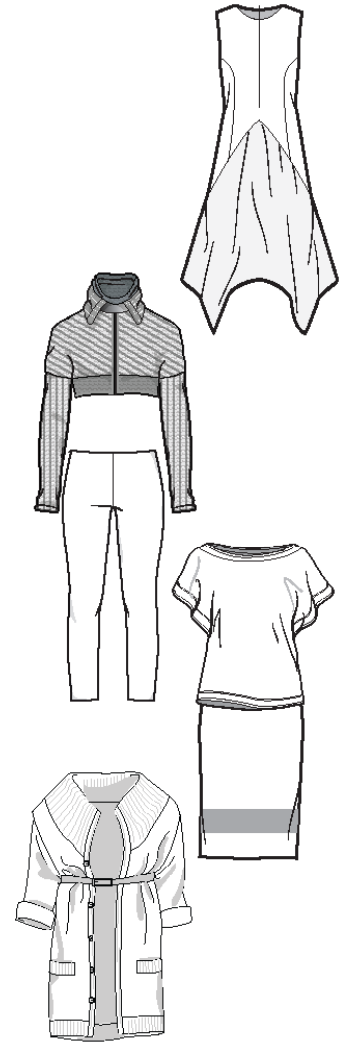
Please bring a portable computer with Garment Designer installed
